- c) Stroud Valley School PTFA - £500 towards a community arts project. This is subject to the project being exhibited in the town centre for a period of time. LGA 1972 s145.

d) Stroud Photo Ages - £500 towards printing, publicity and technical support. This is subject to the association being able to raise the remaining £1315 and also making the exhibition available online, either on their own or the Council's website. LGA 1972 s145.
