Crime and disorder aim

To reduce:

1. Fear of crime
Fear of walking alone

What STC is already doing

supporting town centre housing
promoting better lighting
providing street lighting
planning apps. –taking a/c of security

What else STC could do

more lighting in dark areas
support more evening activity in town

2. Litter

employee for town centre
litter bins in parks – supply
litter bins on request

Council will lead neighbourhood
litter picks

3. Drug and alcohol related

contribute to CCTV
grants for local facilities and
activities
support The Door
provision of YP facilities
liaison with police

more facilities for YP

4. Dog fouling

trained grounds staff
poop scoop bins in parks
supply 'clean it up' stickers

monitor own ward, and
report to dog wardens

5. Antisocial use of cars -
speeding, pavement
parking, etc

funding traffic calming measures
support pedestrianisation
report pavement parking to police

plus

antisocial cycling –
on pavements, against one way signs

burglary

support neighbourhood watch

promote neighbourhood watch

theft from cars and bikes

request cycle lockers at
railway station

plus:

support Victim Support
improve town centre environment
& green spaces
