

## ACCESS AUDIT REVIEW Stroud Bus Station

### Bus Station

Stroud bus station has 8 bus stops in total which are either side of a main road. There are traffic light systems at each end of the station which makes it easy to access all areas of the station. The bus station area is spacious with wide pathways so there is plenty of space for people to wait and allow pedestrians to pass by.

The flags on the bus stops are quite small and may be difficult to identify for an individual with a visual impairment.

Each bus stop has a shelter with seating, meaning an individual with limited mobility but no wheelchair will be able to wait comfortably.

There are bus timetables at each of the bus stops apart from one, however these have quite small font and may be hard to read for people with a visual impairment.

There is a bin on each side of the road and the area is kept tidy. There is also good drainage throughout the pathway meaning there is less risk of a slippery pavement in freezing conditions.
