<b>Historic Building</b>	<b>Conservation Area: Stroud Town Centre Stroud Town Centre NDP area</b>

<p><b>Description</b></p> <p>The corner building of Kendrick Street &amp; Threadneedle Street and part of the important terrace forming the east side of Kendrick Street.</p> <p>Original shop front with corner recessed double doored entrance with transom light over. <b>Age</b>	<b>Fine example of 19<sup>th</sup> century shop front.</b>
<b>Rarity</b>	<b>The only remaining original shop front of the Kendrick Street Terrace, complete and much loved.</b>
<b>Architectural and aesthetic value</b>	<b>Attractive, detailed and flamboyant shop front, a rare survival in this location.</b>

<b>Degree of completeness</b>	<b>Complete 19<sup>th</sup> century shop front, little altered.</b>
<b>Date of inclusion</b>	<b>June 2017</b>
